## 70/24 MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

To approve as a correct record the Parish Council meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2024. The previously circulated minutes were approved and signed by Cllr Ridler.

## 71/24 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES:

a) Cutting/planting of the village triangle: The PC discussed the grasscutting contract because there were concerns about the standard of grasscutting and maintenance of the Village Green. The PC agreed to expand the scope of the contract to cut the triangle every two weeks, this will be subject to an extra charge. The grass needs to be cut around the goalposts, as per the contract. The Councillors discussed the wet weather conditions.

The Clerk will send a copy of the contract to all Parish Councillors and ask Kelvin Newman about the extra charge for the cutting of the triangle.

The PC approved that a Red Hawthorn tree is to be planted on the triangle in October by Richard Ridler. A cost of £ 100.00 was approved.
